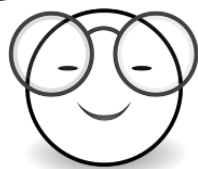


Global Natural History Day 2016

July 20-26, 2016 @Shanghai, China

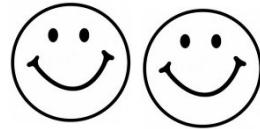
1. Form a team

- Junior Division = Grade 2- 6
- Senior Division = Grade 7 -12
- A team can choose to present in a form of **an exhibit** or **a performance**.

- A mentor can supervise more than 1 team
- Mentor can be a teacher, parent, educator, specialist (18+ yrs. old)

5. Judges are looking for...

- **Natural Science Quality:** accuracy, sources, balanced research, analysis, interpretation and etc..
- **Relation to the Theme**
- **Clear Presentation:** creative, original, visual impact and etc.

 - Input your registration ID
 - Upload your Written Material
 - Confirm to join the competition

- Go to Materials > Download Written Material Form

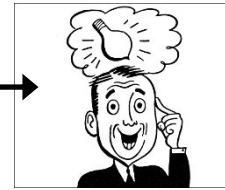
2. How to apply

Think about good questions/topics



Let's start your research

- Start research by focusing on primary sources
 - Primary sources: experiment, interview, data collecting and etc.
 - Secondary sources: reading, web searching, watching documentary and etc..
- Draw conclusions and share your discoveries in an exhibition or a performance

3. Start your project

- Choose topic that relates to the 2016 theme **"Guanxi: Relationships in Nature"**

4. How to present your project

- **Performance:** you have to perform the dramatic portrayal of your topic to 3-4 judges within **8 min.** Then, you'll be questioned by the judges.
- **Exhibit:** you have **5-7 min.** to present to 3-4 judges. Your exhibit can be in any shapes and forms, but not be bigger than **100cm. X 75cm. X 180cm. (WxDxH).** Then, you'll be questioned by the judges.
